What is the itinerary for Friday 17th September?

What is the Professional Masterclass?

It's a squash coaching session given by Nick and Daryl.

There will be three, 40 minute sessions, across all six courts and a maximum of three people per court.

Session 1 will be Juniors only, Sessions 2 and 3 will be for Adults.

Juniors are Under 16 years of age.

Limited ticket availability, book early! See below on how to buy.

What is the On Court with a Pro Session?

It's 15 minutes on court with either Nick or Daryl on a 1-1 basis.

There are only 6 such spaces available and these will be lucky winners of the raffle ticket draw only.

Buy your raffle tickets from Jason, see below.

What is the Raffle?

Winning tickets will be for the 1-1 On Court with a Pro experience as well as for many other top- class prizes. For example, both players are donating signed squash shirts and some Club sponsors and members alike have kindly donated raffle prizes.

Buying raffle tickets enables the Club to both secure this event and also to help run and maintain the excellent squash facilities that we have.

The draw for the On Court with a Pro experience will take place two weeks before the Event, to give winners sufficient advance notice.

The draw for the remaining prizes will take place on Friday 17th September.

What is the Exhibition Match?

A full- on, best of three games match between Nick and Daryl – an opportunity to see squash of the highest calibre close-up on Court 6.

Will Nick and Daryl be available after the Exhibition match?

Yes. A Q&A session will follow the match and the guys will also be available to chat and sign autographs in the bar afterwards. But they will be keen to eat and drink too!

How can I buy tickets? And how much are they?

Raffle tickets can be purchased from Jason at the club, and these tickets can only be purchased by/for club members. They are priced at £5 and there is no limit to the number you can purchase. There are some fabulous prizes!

Tickets for the Professional Masterclass and Exhibition match will go on sale on Sat 31st July at 10am. They can ONLY be purchased by emailing squashevents@lltsc.co.uk. Tickets will not be available to reserve ahead of this date, and cannot be purchased through staff/committee members. Tickets can only be purchased by/for club members, and you may only purchase tickets for members of your household. Tickets will be sold on a first come-first serve basis. Unsuccessful ticket requests will be placed on a waiting list. Payment by BACS must be received by 5pm on 4/8/21. If payment is not received the tickets will be forfeited and offered to members on the waiting list.

Are tickets limited?

Tickets for all of the sessions will be limited. The expectation is that the event will be sold-out and early booking is essential.

Tickets will be restricted to squash members only and to a maximum of four per household for the Exhibition match.

There are no tickets available to non-members, and this event is very much targeted at the squash membership.

Are ticket price discounts available if I book for the Professional Masterclass and the Exhibition match?

No. The tickets are priced to cover the cost of holding the event, and are considered to be very reasonable for an afternoon/evening such as this.

Any additional funds generated by the raffle will be fed back into running and improving the Club.

Will there be food available?

Yes. A food vendor will be at the Club on the night. Specific details and pre-ordering requirements will be available soon. The Exhibition match will start at about 1930 and whilst drinks can be taken through to Court 6 food consumption will be encouraged prior to the match commencing.

Will the Bar be open?

The plan is to open the bar throughout the event, starting at 1600.

Will squash courts be available for members not attending the event?

All six courts will be unavailable from 1600 to 1800. From 1800 onwards Courts 1-4 will be available to book as normal. Courts 5 and 6 will be occupied by the event until it ends at 2100.

Will Club Night run on 17th September?

No, there will not be a Club night.
