2. Court usage

Need to continue to find ways to reduce court wastage as it is often difficult for members to book courts. Also a waste of electricity if lights are on and courts unused. 3 areas to consider:

Committee – plan events to start at the same times that courts start so less wastage before events start.

Members - ensure not making back to back / multi court bookings in peak times **Coaches** - when making block bookings to do so for a term at a time rather than 12 months ahead so no unused courts in holidays etc. Challenges making changes on the booking system so this will also reduce workload.
